Instructions for extended abstract for ICCMCR 2020

Note that the extended abstract for ICCMCR-20 must not exceed **3 printed pages** and can contain figures, tables, or images. Page margins are formed regarding the A4 page size and are 2.5 cm wide from the right, left, top and bottom. Extended abstracts should not exceed 3 pages (maximum 1000 words) including the references and pages should not be numbered

Title: Times New Roman, Size 16,
Bold, Centered, 1.5 line spacing,
with Initial Capital Letters

Authors^a and Authors^{b1}, times new roman, size 13, bold, centered, single spaced, first name before last name (eg. V. Lobo)

^aAffiliation in English, times new roman, size 11, italic and centered

^bAffiliation in English, times new roman, size 11, italic and centered

The **structure of the extended abstract**should have:

 a) Abstract (maximum of 250 words), times new roman, size 13, bold, without indentation, single spaced (one line high). Objectives, methods and findings are summarized in this section.

Keywords (*italic* and bold): Maximum three, written with 10 font size and separated with semicolon

(capitalize only for the first character)

a) Introduction

Text: times new roman, size 12.

- b) **Methodology**
- c) Results and Discussion
- d) Conclusions: Please conclude with the most important finding as well as future works (3-4 lines).
- e) Acknowledgement (option)
- f) References

2.1 Table, figure and equations

Format for table and figure are as in Table

Equations should be labeled as in Equation (1) with a number towards the right margin, in case there is more than one equation.

legends in English. Insert them nearby the place where they are mentioned in the text. Units (according to IUPAC).

- b) as previous study [1-4].
- c) as previous study [2,5,7].

- d) For one or two authors: "...Amiruddin and Abdollah [3] stated that"
- e) For more than two authors: "...Abdollah et al. [2] found that"
