Policy Catering to Needs of Different Categories of Learners

The IQAC Meeting held on 10/06/2020 resolved to formulate a policy catering to the needs of students of the college coming from various sectors of the society and having different socio-economic backgrounds. The proposed guidelines were formulated and submitted to the College staff council for perusal and suggestions.

The following Policy guidelines are approved by the staff council.

1. All Departments are advised to conduct the first internal test and identify Slow Learners, Average Advanced Learners and outstanding learners on the basis of the marks obtained.

Categories based on test

Slow Learners < 40 marks

Average Learners- 41-60 marks

Advanced Learners-61-80 marks

Outstanding Learners > 81 marks

Slow Learners

- Remedial classes will be made mandatory for all students under this category.
- Remedial classes shall be conducted as sessions before / after regular teaching hours.
- Assignments and quizzes are to be given on a regular basis.
- They will be encouraged to participate in academic activities of respective departments.
- Towards the end of each month, a performance evaluation will be made.

Average Learners

- They can attend the remedial classes with the recommendation of the tutor concerned.
- They will be encouraged to prepare class notes and answer the previous years question papers, which in turn will be evaluated by the teacher concerned.

Advanced Learners

- They will be encouraged to prepare essays on contemporary issues and will be asked to discuss it with the class during free time.
- They will be encouraged to participate in peer teaching for Slow Learners and asked to help average learners with problem solving sessions.
- They will be motivated to prepare for competitive examinations like JAM, NET, CSIR etc.
- They will be encouraged to do online courses like MOOC and NPTEL.
- They are to be also encouraged to participate and present papers in seminars.


Outstanding Learners

- They are to be encouraged to apply for student projects financed by different institutions.
- They will be given opportunity to represent the institution in intercollegiate, state level and national level programs.
- They will be given opportunities to attend the motivational talks given by eminent personalities.
- They will be given cash awards, certificates, medals for their outstanding performance.
- All departments are advised to keep separate registers for remedial teaching, peer teaching and tutorial.

These registers shall contain

- The syllabus
- List of faculties engaging classes
- Number of class hours engaged
- Student attendance with date and time
- Signature of teacher coordinator
- Counter signature of Head of the Department
