The English Association 'AELSA' and Seminar Committee jointly organized a seminar on Feminism titled "When Language Fails: Reading Women's Narratives" in the Digital Seminar Hall on 5th February 2019 at 10:00 am.

The Department of English and Seminar Committee jointly organized a seminar on Informatics titled "Informatics: Operating Systems, Networking and Internet" in the Smart Classroom on 6th August 2018 at 10:30 am.

The Department has been conducting Communicative English classes for the students of various schools around the college. Many students participated very actively and prizes were distributed for the best poster and oral contest winners.

The World Wetland Day-2019 programme was conducted on 5th and 6th February 2019 at Digital Seminar Hall, K.S.M.D.B College, Sasthamcotta. The programme titled 'SAVE WETLANDS, SAVE YOURSELF' was funded by Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE), Govt. of Kerala. The programme was jointly organized by Research and P.G Department of Chemistry and Science Club of the college with the cooperation and involvement of local government. On 5th February, poster and oral presentation contests were conducted based on the focal theme 'Wetlands and Climate Change'. There was very active participation from the students. Once the threats of flood subsided, the next task that lies ahead of the Keralites is the cleaning up mission. For thus, on the






WORLD WETLAND DAY


