Curriculum Evaluation Report (2018-19)

The college runs 15 UG programs, 5 PG programs and 2 research programs.

The curriculum fixed by University of Kerala, which is getting revised in every 3 years, is

followed in K S M D B College also.

Methodology:

As part of analysis of curriculum, a structured questionnaire is prepared and feedback is

collected from 4 major stakeholders; viz; students, teachers, alumni and parents. The variables

considered and the feedback received from various stakeholders is mentioned in the report:

Feedback of Students about the Program

K S M D B College has 14 academic departments which run 15 UG programs and out of it 5

departments run 5 PG program also. Sample size is fixed as 10, for each year of UG batch and

5 for each year of PG batch. On that basis, data is collected from 470 students covering 1st year


degree, 2nd year degree, 3rd year degree, 1st year PG and 2nd year PG. The findings are

 As far availability of online and offline materials concerned, the students expressed satisfaction.


Feedback of Faculty about the Program

Findings:

The key point of the feedback is mentioned below:

- 1. Like the students, faculty is also satisfied by the curriculum administered by the University of Kerala for their contents concerned.
- 2. Majority (79%) of the faculty has given a positive feedback regarding the curriculum.
- 3. Prospects of higher education followed by updation of syllabus are ranked highly by the faculty team. 86 % of them admired the fact.
- 4. A majority of the faculty bench are of the opinion that the programmes are beneficial for their job potential. However, 31% of the respondents are not in agreement with the majority view. They say that more job-oriented courses should be introduced to make the students able to utilize the coming opportunities.

Feedback of Alumni about the Program



Findings:

The major finding from the survey conducted among the alumni of K S M D B College, gave the following insights:

- Majority (82%) of the alumni feels that the curriculum is meeting the required standard.
- They are of the view that the curriculum helped the students in their higher studies.

• The employment prospects of the programmes are good. However a 20% of the respondents disagree with the majority opinion.

Conclusion:

The feedback mechanism gave an excellent rating to the program by the primary stakeholder i.e. student, and also by other stakeholders like faculty and alumni. The academic excellence in curriculum and its delivery is getting reflected in outcome parameters like ranks, university results, application number, demand for various programs etc. However certain improvements are expected in areas like job prospects and availability of study materials. The aspects of feedback are given to the Principal to report to the Travancore Devaswom Board.
