

National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) is a project of MHRD initiated by seven Indian Institutes of Technology (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Guwahati and Roorkee) along with the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 2003, to provide quality education to anyone interested in learning from the IITs. The main goal was to create web and video courses in all major branches of engineering and physical sciences at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and management courses at the postgraduate level. NPTEL provides Online Certification Courses through an online portal with 4 to 8 or 12-week online courses, typically on topics relevant to students in all years of higher education along with basic core courses in sciences and humanities with exposure to relevant tools and technologies. NPTEL provides FDP courses also. NPTEL provide two sessions every year, January –April and July – December respectively. SWAYAM NPTEL Local Chapter co-ordinated by IIT Madras was established in our college on 16-07-2020 with ID (LC ID) 4027. Our college nominated Dr. Shemeena Basheer N, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics as the single point of contact (SPOC) of the local chapter. Various departments in our college selected appropriate courses for the students for both Jan-April and July-December batches and same courses were provided twice a year. The corresponding departments selected mentors for the proper running of these courses. During the year 2020-2021, about 462 students from various disciplines enrolled in different courses.
