She pointed out that IPR is no more confined to the legal fraternity , but has spread across all disciplines because of which it has an impact and significance on arts, science, commerce, management and business. Then she discussed on different aspects of intellectual properties like industrial design, geographical indication, trade secret, protection of farmers’ rights and researchers’ rights. She concluded the talk by explaining the rationale of protection and the nature of IPR. She emphasized that IPR has to be




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renewed from time to time for keeping them in force except in case of copyright and trade secrets. This session went up to 12.45 pm followed by 10 minutes of interaction with participants. The workshop was concluded at 1.00 pm by a vote of thanks by Dr. B.Beena, Convener, Research Committee.




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
